Downs and District Veterans Golf Association DDVGA 2017 Committee Meeting

At a committee in 2017, Ron Weekes asked the question of where are our records of past Champions and committee members are, and how the club started. At this point no one had any answers so I, Merv Nugent, President, asked Ron to start looking into this project.

Ron had found old minutes and AGM minutes that our Secretary Ken Corney had in his possession. This started the ball rolling. One day I spoke to past President Ian Maclean and asked if he has any history we could use. Ian presented me with two honour boards with past winners and years of past Champions that was given to him from past Captain Leo Lunney. This got the ball rolling again, now we had names and years of past winners of 1984 to 1996, and later received from Captain Leo Lunney his documents which had past winners.

We were missing past Champions and Grade winners from 1991 to 2001, which lead me to the library to look at the old Toowoomba Chronicle papers for results that were on microfilm. I achieved nearly all of the winners back to 1991, as no results went into papers prior to 1991 from the old minutes I had read. 1997 Champion was found but not grade winners at this stage.

The aim now is to have all this history on our website for future generations to see and to be updated yearly. We have put a lot of time and energy to get all this information so we hope members appreciate this.

Golfers in Queensland

When I started looking into the history, I found this heading "Darling Downs and South Western Queensland Golf Association" on the letter sent to all clubs on the Downs area. Then wondering how that name came about, I looked on Trove and found how it came about as below.

Queensland Golf Council 1931

The control of golf in Queensland then was by Queensland Golf Council, which consists of three constituent clubs - Brisbane Golf Club, Royal Queensland Golf Club and Indooroopilly Golf Club, and also delegates from various affiliated associations (outer Metropolitan, Morton, South Coast, Darling Downs and South West Queensland, Wide Bay and Burnett, Central Queensland, North Queensland and Far North Queensland).

The total number of members of constituent and affiliated clubs was a little short of 8000.

This is how Darling Downs and South Western Queensland Golf Association name was created.

Veteran Golf Started in Queensland in 1973 with the Gold Coast Veterans

It was not until 1980 that Veteran Golf started to expand in Queensland when Mr John Martin formed a veterans club at Redland Bay where he was a member. He was also a member of the Gold Coast.

John then approached the Oxley Golf Club in regards to the forming of a Veteran movement in Queensland.

In 1982 the Oxley Veteran Club was first formed followed by Carbrook in that same year.

Mt Warren Park formed a veteran Club in 1983 followed by The Downs & District. The Queensland Veteran Golf Union was also formed in 1983 and to this day has a total of twenty-one (21) districts.

The first 36-hole State Championship was held at the Gold Coast in 1983. Championships were played at Oxley 1984, Toowoomba 1986, Gold Coast 1987, Oxley 1987, Noosa 1989, Toowoomba 1990, Gold Coast 1991.

The Australian National Veteran Golf Championship was held in Toowoomba in 1993 comprising a field of 242 Players. (Toowoomba Golf Club).



The Downs and District Veteran Golf Association Inc History 1983 onwards

A few Members of the D.D.S.W.Q. decided to start a Veteran Golfers Association on the Downs. D.D.S.W.Q. Golf Association sent this letter out to all clubs within the association.

Notice of Meeting

A meeting will be held at the Toowoomba Golf Club (Middle Ridge) on Monday night, 29th August commencing at 8.00pm.

The meeting is called for the purpose of forming a Veterans Golf Association within the area of the D.D.& S.W.Q. Golf Association.

To qualify as a Veteran Golfer, you are required to be 55 years or over and to have an Australian handicap.

We would like your club to indicate if you have anyone interested in joining as a Veteran Golfer by letter or attending the meeting.

Meeting 29th August 1983

A meeting took place at Toowoomba Golf Club, after 4 months on researching the requirements to form a Veteran Golfers Association by Mr Harth.

At this meeting Mr Harth asked the committee if they agreed to forming a District Veterans Golf Association.

It was moved by Mr E Connell, seconded by Mr W Young 'that this meeting is forming a District Veterans Golf Association.'

Moved by Mr C Leicht, seconded by Mr C Badcock (Carried) 'that the new Association be titled The Downs and District Veteran Golf Association' (Carried).

The start of a long history in DDVGA on 29/8/1983

As a matter of interest, DDVGA had 32 player's first game at City Golf Club and 36 second and 38 third game.

First Committee Meeting was on 19th September 1983

Mr Chas Leicht offered the association \$250 for trophies over a 12 month period, this was gracefully accepted.

The City Golf Club was approached to make the City Golf Club the Vets' home base. Account was opened at Heritage Building Society in November 1983. The first Championship was held at City Golf Club, 99 players attended. The Q.V.G.U. imposed a \$1 per member fee to be paid to Q.V.G.U. to help run State Affairs.

The Downs and District Golf Association has staged two Queensland Veteran Championships. In 1993 we had a very successful Australian National Championship, the first for Queensland with 224 players in the field and players from 7 states.

The main honour board events held during the year were the Bill Beck Memorial Shield, played in January. The Joffe Thompson Memorial Shield was played during Carnival of Flowers week from 1985 to 1995.

The cedar timber Joffe Thompson Shield was donated by the three Thompson members, Max, John L and John D.

The shield was made from timber sawn from a sixty-year-old tree which stood beside the fifth fairway at the Toowoomba Golf Club.

The Gold Coast, Ipswich, and the Downs Veterans played for the Thompson Shield at Ipswich Golf Club in March each year from 1992 to 2008 (note Gold Coast pulled out 2006).

Ozzie Baker from Ipswich told me he has the Thompson Shield that was cut out of the same tree as the Joffe Thompson Shield from the Toowoomba Golf Club.

J D Thompson

In 1984 John D Thompson was elected Secretary of the Downs and District Veteran Golf Association Inc when membership totalled fifty-four. J D has played no small part in increasing membership to over 300.

He played a leading role in organising two Queensland Veterans and one Australian Veterans Championship at the Toowoomba Golf Club, and was also Vice President of the Queensland Veterans Golf Union.

J D held that position for 27 years (1983 to 2010).

Jack Robinson

Jack joined the Vets in 1984 and has been a big part ever since. He was elected onto Committee in 1999 and was still there until 2014. Jack helped with the computer programme 'Top Score' in 2003, entering scores for all games for presentations up until 2018 when we stopped using that programme.

He still is involved helping out in 2019 wherever he can as he loves the Vets (another J D Thompson).

Joffe Thompson Shield

Joffe Thompson Shield was held from 1985 to 1995 and was played during Carnival of Flowers week in September.

1988: Joffe Thompson was awarded Life Membership. Joffe was one of our first committee members and donation of the Joffe Thompson Shield 1983 - 1988.

1992: Ron Myring was Captain for 11 years (1983 - 1993) and awarded LM 1992.

1992: Reg Sweet elected in 1983 to Committee for 3 years, Vice-Captain (1986 -1993) for 8 years totalling 11 years. Awarded LM 1992.

1995: Cliff Harth, President for 3 years (1983 - 1986) and also was Patron for 13 years (1983 - 1999). Awarded LM 1995.

2000: John Macaulay was granted LM in 2000 for the 23 years of service as Treasurer (1988 - 2010).

2001: Jack McCaffery was on Committee for 16 years (1991 - 2008), next 8 years as our Patron (2010 - 2018). Awarded LM 2001.

2002: Ian Parkinson, was Captain for 8 years (1994 - 2001) and then Patron (2005 - 2009). He was not Patron in 2008. Awarded LM 2002.

2004: J D Thompson was on committee for 27 years. J D Thompson took over the role of Secretary in 1983 and occupied this position right up until 2010. Awarded LM 2004. Secretary John basically was in charge of running the day to day of the association. He organised all weekly competitions which entails contact with all various clubs where we play each year. He negotiated suitable green fees and lunch prices at all clubs.

To occupy the voluntary position of Secretary of the D.D.V.G.A. Inc for over 27 years has made a contribution to the welfare of his fellow veteran golfers. There fore in 2007 he was awarded OAM in Australia Day Honours for some 27 years of service to D.D.V.G.A.

2004: Keith Spry joined the association in 1985 and was elected to Committee in 1992 and again in 1993. In 1994 he became Vice President and then in 1995 became President of DDVGA to 1999. Later in Keith became President of Q.V.G.U. Awarded LM 2004.

2008: Jack Robinson was on Committee from 1999 - 2001, then 2003 - 2014 total of 15 years. Jack joined in 1984. 35 years as a member and still playing golf in 2019, and still works as a sub-committee 2019. Awarded LM 2008.

2015: Leo Lunney was on Committee 13 years - a playing member from 1990, elected to Committee in 1992, served as Vice-Captain for 6 years and Captain for 8 years. Awarded LM 2015.

He also represented the Downs at the Q.V.G.U. quarterly meeting in Brisbane. Leo was given Certificate of Appreciation from the Australian Veteran Golfers Union Inc, in recognition of outstanding services given in support of Veteran Golfers in Queensland in 2011.

2018 Ian Maclean joined D.D.V.G.A. in 1990. In 2007 he became Vice President until 2010, then in 2011 he was elected to President to 2015 and in 2016 stayed on as vice President. Awarded LM 2018.

Foundation Member

Chas Leicht was Vice Captain from 1983 to 1986 as well as being Foundation Member, he was President from 1987 to 1990.


