## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

A 36-hole stableford event shall be played in handicap **groups over two (2) consecutive days (18 holes per day)**. Entrants **must hold a current Golf Australia handicap and must be a financial member of a Veteran Golf Club, District or Association affiliated with the AVGU and must have played in at least three veteran competitions in the six months prior to the Championship. Strict adherence to this rule will apply.**

**The closing date for nominations will be Friday 25<sup>th</sup> September 2020 or earlier if maximum field is achieved.** A draw will be conducted immediately following the close of nominations and will be posted to the QVGU website ([www.qvgu.com.au](http://www.qvgu.com.au)) on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2020. No refunds will be issued after the closing date, except in exceptional circumstances.

With the exception of nearest-the-pin shots, players may receive only one trophy over the two days.

Players may register at the City Golf Club on Sunday 11th October between 1:00pm and 4.00pm, or at least 30 minutes before their scheduled hit-off time on the Monday. **Handicaps must be verified and proof of veteran membership (QVGU Membership Card) must be produced at registration.**

All players will be required to report to the tournament officials at the Office near the Pro Shop at least 30 minutes prior to their hit-off time each day. The starter will call players at least 10 minutes prior to their tee time. Players not responding may be sent to the end of the field or to a time at the starter's discretion. All players are expected to maintain their place in the field and to obey the instructions of the Course Marshall. A two (2) stroke penalty may be incurred for slow play. **In the event of a tie for the 36-hole gross event, the Championship will be decided by a playoff over such hole/holes as designated by the Tournament Director.** If a playoff is not possible the state champion will be decided by a count back. All other winners will be decided by count back. The Rules of Golf shall apply and be read in conjunction with any **local rules** applicable at the time. Any special rules invoked by the Queensland Veteran Golf Union Inc., the Tournament Director or the Match Committee of the Downs and District Veterans Golfers Association shall be final and binding.

The Match Committee, at its discretion reserves the right to limit the field (if necessary) in order of receipt of entry forms. A stand-by list will be created if necessary. The Committee also reserves the right to draw entrants in early or late tee times. However, where possible

City Golf Club Women's dress standards will apply. Cotton or knit tops with round or V neck, sleeves or sleeveless and either tailored shorts, slacks or skirt (Strapless or shoestring, boob tubes, halter necks and midriffs are not permitted on the course). In the club house, shoes or dress sandals may be worn. Rubber thongs are not permitted.

Steel spikes are not permitted.
