

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entrants must hold a current Golf Australia handicap and must be a financial member of a Veteran Golf Club, District or Association affiliated with the AVGU and must have played in at least three veteran competitions in the twelve months prior to the Carnival. Strict adherence to this rule will apply. **QVGU Membership Card must be produced at registration.**

The closing date for nominations will be Friday 23rd September 2022 or earlier if maximum field is achieved. A draw will be conducted immediately following the close of nominations and will be posted to the QVGU website (www.qvqu.com.au) on Friday 30th September. No refunds will be issued after the closing date, except in exceptional circumstances.

With the exception of nearest-the-pin shots, players may receive only one trophy over the two days. Players may register at the Woodford Golf Club on Sunday 9th October between 3pm and 5pm, or at least 30 minutes before their scheduled hit-off time on the Monday. **Handicaps will be verified, and proof of veteran membership (QVGU Membership Card) must be produced at registration. No Membership Card Produced No Play.**

All players will be required to report to the tournament officials near the Pro Shop at least 30 minutes prior to their hit-off time each day. The starter will call players at least 10 minutes prior to their tee time. Players not responding may be sent to the end of the field or to a time at the starter's discretion. All players are expected to maintain their place in the field and to obey the instructions of the Course Marshall. A two (2) stroke penalty may be incurred for slow play.

SCORING APP MAY BE USED. HARD COPY OF SCORE CARD MUST BE ENTERED ON COMPLETION.

In the event of a tie for the State Carnival Champion, the winner will be decided by a playoff over such hole/holes as designated by the Tournament Director. If a playoff is not possible the Champion will be decided by a count back. All other winners will be decided by count back.

The Rules of Golf shall apply and be read in conjunction with any **local rules** applicable at the time. Any special rules invoked by the Queensland Veteran Golf Union Inc., the Tournament Director or the Match Committee of the Woodford Veterans Golf Club shall be final and binding.

The Match Committee reserves the right to limit the field (if necessary) in order of receipt of entry forms. A stand-by list will be created if necessary. The Committee also reserves the right to draw entrants in early or late tee times.

ALL CANCELLATIONS MUST BE ADVISED TO TOURNAMENT SECRETARY.
