## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

A 36 hole event of individual stroke play shall be played in handicap groups over two (2) consecutive days (18 holes per day)

Entrants must hold a current Golf Australia handicap and must be a financial member of a Veteran Golf Club, District or Association affiliated with the AVGU and must have played in at least three veteran competitions in the six months prior to the Championship. Strict adherence to this rule will apply.

The closing date for nominations will be Friday 19<sup>th</sup> April 2024 or earlier if maximum field is achieved. A draw will be conducted immediately following the close of nominations and will be posted to the QVGU website (<a href="www.qvgu.com.au">www.qvgu.com.au</a>) on Wednesday 6th May. Should you require a copy of the draw then include a stamped, self-addressed envelope with your Nomination Form.

With the exception of the State Champion Trophy, the Gerry Fitzgerald trophy and the Ken Gibbins trophy and nearest-the-pin shots, players may receive only one trophy.

Players register at least 20 minutes before their scheduled hit-off time on the Monday. Handicaps must be verified and proof of veteran membership (QVGU Membership Card) must be produced at registration.

All players will be required to report to the starting officials at least 20 minutes prior to their hit-off time each day. The starter will call players at least 10 minutes prior to their tee time. Players not responding may be sent to the end of the field or to a time at the starter's discretion. All players are expected to maintain their place in the field and to obey the instructions of the Course Marshall. A two (2) stroke penalty may be incurred for slow play.

In the event of a tie for the 36 hole gross event, the Championship will be decided by a playoff over such hole/holes as designated by the Tournament Director. If a playoff is not possible the state champion will be decided by a count back. All other winners will be decided by count back.

The Rules of Golf shall apply and be read in conjunction with any **local rules** applicable at the time. Any special rules invoked by the Queensland Veteran Golf Union Inc., the Tournament Director, or Match Committee of the Maroochy River Veteran Golfers shall be final and binding. The Match Committee, at its discretion reserves the right to limit the field (if necessary) in order of receipt of entry forms. A stand-by list will be created if necessary. The Committee also reserves the right to draw entrants in early or late tee times. However, where possible A Grade players will not hit off before 10.30 am on both days.

Maroochy River Golf Club dress standards will apply. Shirts must have a collar, short socks (predominately white and above the ankles) and long socks must always be pulled up. **Steel spikes are not permitted**.
