Blessed with fine weather and great company, the day was a celebration of skill, sportsmanship, and tradition. The Irish Stableford format added a strategic twist: counting the single best score for their group of four players, on holes 1–6, the best two scores for holes 7–12, and the three best scores for holes 13–18.
